Hardware Specifications:

The laptop must meet **all** of the following requirements:

Type of laptop	Laptop or 2-in-1 device Note: mobile phones are not approved devices and iPads/tablets are not recommended
Physical Dimensions	Minimum Screen Size: 10"
Operating System	Windows 10 (not 'S Mode') – version 21H2 or above (Apple MacOS and Google Chromebook are not recommended)
Wireless Compatibility	Laptop must support 5GHz dual band This may be advertised as "Dual Band Wireless", "802.11abgn", "802.11agn", "802.11ac" or "Gigabit Wireless". Battery Life	Advertised battery life of at least five hours

Additional Considerations:

The following are not essential but are suggestions as to what else you should consider:

Recommendations	Weight: ensure you select a laptop that is suitable for your child to carry RAM: 8GB minimum (although 16GB is recommended)
	Disk configuration: Solid State Drive (SSD) – minimum 128GB (240GB is recommended
	CPU: Pentium or equivalent minimum (i3 or above is recommended)
Insurance	Accidental loss and breakage insurance
